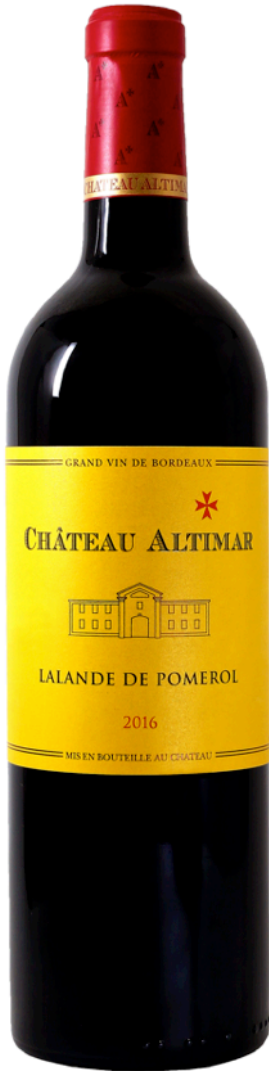

Area: **1,7 ha**

Soils: **Clay and gravelly Clays**

Grape Varieties: **55% Cabernet Franc,**

35% Merlot,

10% Cabernet Sauvignon

Density: **6 000 vines / ha**

Yields: **40 à 45 hl / ha**

Age of the vineyard: **35 years old**

VITICULTURE : **Organic** and HVE3 since 2018

Traditionnal pruning, manual budding

No herbicide, plowing under the vines

Organic treatments

Manual deleafing on one face

Hand harvest, sorted and vibrating table

VINIFICATION/AGEING :

Vinification in thermoregulated and stainless still tanks

Cold maceration for a maximal extraction of colors and flavors

Malolactic fermentation in oak barrel

Ageing in French oak barrel during 15 months

Unfiltered wine, no fining

Production : 10.000 bottles / 800 cases

TASTING NOTES:

2014 : This is a bold, ripe and spicy wine. With firm tannins contrasting with the rich perfumed Cabernet Franc fruits, this is a wine with good potential. The dry edge will soften as the wine matures and create a dense concentration.

2016 : 92/100 Powered by bold tannins, this is a richly structured wine. The tannins are balanced by generous black-plum and berry fruits spiced with licorice and wood-aging flavors. Drink this complex wine from 2022. ROGER VOSS (Wine Enthusiast)

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
